Ruishton Book Club 'The Hare with Amber Eyes', is a family memoir written by British ceramicist Edmund de Waal. The Ephrussi family were once a very wealthy European Jewish banking dynasty. Almost everything they owned was lost in 1938 and even after the Second World War the family failed to recover most of it's property. An easily hidden collection of 264 Japanese netsuke (miniature sculptures) was saved and now has passed down through five generations. This book went from a ponderous script that lost focus (a difficult read), to a moving sobering tale of family history in the Second World War.

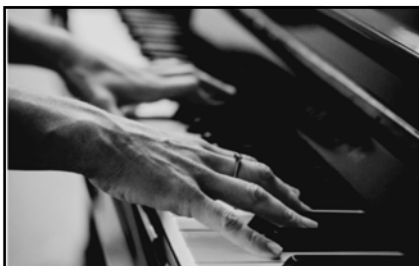

The Council has now decided to plant a flowering cherry tree in Lawn Meadow to replace a crab apple tree that was deliberately destroyed last year.

The Annual Parish Assembly will be held on **10th May 2018 at 7.00pm** in the Village Hall. The purpose of the Assembly is to enable the registered electors to discuss parish affairs. The meeting is also an opportunity for the Parish Council to report on the activities over the last year. An elector may ask questions, comments on parish issues and propose and vote on resolutions.

Unfortunately, the Police and Crime Commissioner, Sue Mountstevens, is not free on that night but she is willing to attend a Council meeting on a suitable date. However, the Neighbourhood Plan Steering Group will give a presentation on the Neighbourhood Plan Visions and Objectives that have emerged as a result of the recent Household Survey and, in light of the recent bad weather, the Council will be asking for your views on an agenda item 'Emergency Planning'

ROAD SAFETY

County Councillor John Thorne attended a workshop in County Hall on road safety where it was reported that the most recent statistics were not available, but there are fewer accidents and fewer casualties on our roads now than ever before. Nevertheless, the road safety team want to target older motorists (defined as 60+) because they are a significant proportion of the casualties which do occur. They are offering to visit communities and hold a free session and bring along their simulator.
